Topic: Electrical Cabinets

Customers that have a 100v power supply at the back of their machines need to be cautious of debris build up inside of the cabinet. The power supply panel location can vary depending on the model of the machine, but usually it is located either on the left or right side rear of the machine in the base.

POTENTIAL FIRE HAZARD: This area needs to be kept free of excessive debris build up, which may cause extreme heat to the transformer.



Electrical cabinets must be kept clean of debris and filters clean or changed on regular basis if applicable. Machines vary by model. Use vacuum cleaner.
Caution: Power must be removed from machine at main shut off.
Use caution when using air due to static discharge damage to circuit
