





APRIL 2010 SHODA TECHNICAL BULLETIN


This month I have a crucial topic that needs to be addressed as most machines still have their original Mitsubishi PLC back up batteries installed. <u>If battery fails Machine PLC</u> will be lost upon power down of machine. These batteries need to be replaced ASAP and you will want to keep a record of replacement date. Please pay special attention to notes below.

Topic: Mitsubishi PLC Backup battery replacement. (Hitachi PLC not necessary)

Location: Left side of Mitsubishi PLC in Electrical Cabinet.

CAUTION: PLC needs to be backed up prior to Battery replacement. Special Software needed to perform this procedure. This procedure should be performed by a Qualified Technician only or verify with TSG if PLC back up has been performed.

Extreme Caution: Battery replacement must be performed with power on. Shock Hazard.



Note: <u>Caution</u> needs to be used when purchasing new replacement battery. Many batteries have the same part number as this battery but are not a direct replacement for this specific battery.
