- 1. <u>Air conditioning units:</u> Units need to be cleaned of heavy debris build up between coils. Filters need to be kept cleaned out on a regular basis.
- 2. <u>Electrical Cabinets</u>: Cabinets need to be kept cleaned out on regular basis to prevent over heating and intermittent failures. Caution: Static electricity damage may occur if not done properly.
- 3. <u>Inverters:</u> Fans need be checked for proper operation and interior of units need to be cleaned out to prevent overheating. Caution: Static electricity damage may occur if not done properly.

CAUTION: MACHINE POWER MUST BE TURNED OFF. ONLY USE CANNED DRY AIR ON ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS IN CABINETS AND INVERTERS DUE TO POSSIBILITY OF STATIC DAMAGE. DO NOT TOUCH CIRCUIT BOARDS UNLESS GROUNDED.
